



A consistent worry for caregivers is the risk of seizures occurring when a dog is alone.

Toby's Foundation is pleased to announce that we are giving \$10,000 to co-sponsor a Morris Animal Foundation (MAF) grant for Dr. Karen Munana at North Carolina State University College of Veterinary Medicine (NCSU-CVM). Researchers will investigate the use of a commercially available, collar mounted activity monitor to detect seizures in dogs with epilepsy. The availability of an easily worn, inexpensive device to detect seizures will provide valuable data to help veterinarians make informed treatment adjustments, and reduce the risk of injury or death from unobserved seizures for their canine patients.
